## Accrediting Your Thoroughbred

**Even though a mare can be accredited after foaling, that foal will not be eligible for breeder's awards unless the mare is accredited by paying the supplemental fee by December 31 of the same year of foaling.**

1. First, the foal must have been dropped in Texas; if not, it is ineligible for the Accredited Texas-Bred Program, even if all other requirements are met.

2. The foal's dam must be an Accredited Texas Mare. If she is not, then she must become accredited in order for the foal to be eligible. To accredit a mare, you must submit:

- A. A completed mare application;
- B. The appropriate accreditation fee; and
- C. A copy of the mare's Jockey Club papers (both front and back) that show your ownership.

3. If these requirements have been met, then the next step is to accredit the foal. To do this, you must submit:

- A. A completed foal application;
- B. Applicable accreditation fee:

C. Important note about the ATB Application for Weanlings, Yearlings, and Horses of Racing Age – Do not send in the original Jockey Club certificate of registration – send a copy only. You will be sent a sticker verifying Accredited Texas-bred status which must be affixed to the original Jockey Club certificate.

4. If you are not a current member of the TTA at the time you attempt to accredit your horse, either:

- A. The accreditation fee required per horse will be increased by \$50; or
- B. You can join or renew your membership in the TTA at whatever level you choose (membership packages start at \$60; call TTA (512) 458-6133 for more information).

# TTA Member and Non-Member Accreditation Fees

## CURRENT FEES

### Weanlings, Yearlings and Horses of Racing Age

\$75	\$125	If application and fees are postmarked by May 31 of the foal's yearling year. DO NOT MISS ANY DEADLINE WAITING FOR JOCKEY CLUB REGISTRATION. PLEASE SEND IN THE APPLICATION AND FEE. DO NOT SEND IN PAPERS: SEE APPLICATION FORM.
\$200	\$250	If application and fees are postmarked between June 1 and December 31 of the horse's yearling year.

### For foals of 2015 and earlier:

<b>\$1,500</b>	<b>\$1,550</b>	<b>If application and fees are postmarked on or after January 1 of the horse's 2-year-old year.</b>

### For foals of 2016 and later:

<b>\$750</b>	<b>\$800</b>	<b>If application and fees are postmarked between January 1 and December 31 of the horse's 2-year-old year.</b>
<b>\$1,500</b>	<b>\$1,550</b>	<b>If application and fees are postmarked on or after January 1 of the horse's 3-year-old year..</b>

### Broodmares

\$75	\$125	One-time, lifetime accreditation fee. (Note: a mare must be accredited with the TTA prior to the birth of her foal to be eligible for "Breeder's Awards" on that foal.)
\$150	\$200	One-time, supplemental lifetime accreditation fee to accredit a broodmare with a Texas-foaled weanling after the date of foaling but before December 31 of the same year of foaling, and still be eligible to receive ATB Breeder Awards on the subject foal. (Effective for foals of 2008 and later.)
\$30	\$100	Convert racing to breeding stock.

### Stallions

\$100	\$150	One-time, lifetime accreditation fee, plus:
\$200	\$200	Annual administration fees to insure stallion awards only. Due on or before February 1 of each year.
\$325	\$325	Late administrative fee if paid after February 1 of any given year. Late fee will not be accepted if postmarked after August 1.

**No awards will be paid unless the required documentation is on file with the Texas Thoroughbred Association.**
